






INSTALLATION




Like all Skid steer accessories, installation is very simple. The fastener is composed of 2 angled top plate on the top and 2 rectangular holes on the bottom. Make sure that the components of the tractor and the set of forks and spears are clean and free of mud, stone, branches, and the like. This could harm the good operation of the equipment and may be dangerous.

STEP-BY-STEP



With your tractor, tip the connection harness toward the ground (As if you were emptying a bucket). Lower the loader and bring the tractor harness against your Skid Steer implement.

Then slowly raise the loader so that the top plates inserts together. Once the top plates are in place, flip the loader harness backwards, as if to fill in a bucket. Skid Steer back plate will lean firmly on the tractor harness. Ensure that the Skid Steer implement and the harness are completely leaning against each other and that nothing is between the two. Then



engage the latches on the tractor harness to lock your Skid Steer implement in place.



CONFIGURATION

Your set of forks comes with 3 hay spears and 2 pallet forks. The main harness includes space for the 2 forks and 4 sleeves for the various configurations. Here are some of the possibilities according to the work being done.



It is important to understand the operation and limits of the various components of the implement. Your safety is a priority! Take the time to properly attach the various parts before use. No tools are required to change configurations.

Transport pallets



For this configuration, you only have to remove the 3 hay spears. To do this, remove the spring pins behind the assembly. This will unlock the spears and you can remove them by simply pulling them forward. Be careful not to stab yourself when removing them!





Large and small round bales

To do this, you must remove the pallet forks. Lift the safety lock above the forks hooks and slide the forks one by one towards the center. A space is left on the bottom rail to remove the fork in this position. Once in the center, raise the front of the fork and remove it. Repeat the same process for the second fork. To put them back in place, just do the reverse operations. For the round bale configuration, you must also remove the 2 side spears (if present). You must then install 2 spears in the central sleeves.

Large square bales



For this configuration you will need to remove the pallet forks (see previous configuration) and install the 3 hay spears. This will provide excellent support for your hay bales. It is also possible to put the 3 spears in line on the bottom rail, as this configuration is recommended for large square bales.



SAFETY




Your safety is important. Don't take risks with heavy equipment. Your life and that of the people around you depend on it. Here are the basic safety rules for this type of equipment.

- Ensure the harness is securely locked in place on the tractor when installing;
- Ensure that the forks are properly attached to the top and bottom rails and that the safety lock on the top is engaged;
- Ensure that the spring pins behind the hay spears are in place and that the snap ring
 is closed to lock the pin in place;
- Wear safety boots when operating machinery;
- NEVER step or stand under the pallet fork and hay spears assembly.
- ALWAYS maintain a safe distance with the machinery;
- The operator is responsible for the safety of people and property around him. Be alert to your surroundings;
- Never exceed the limits indicated on the label bearing the serial number;
- Drive the spears fully into the hay bale until the bale is against the harness;
- Enter pallet forks fully under the load and that at least 2/3 of its length is supported;
- Raise the load vertically until it no longer touches the ground, then tilt it backward;
- Ensure that the load does not catch into neighboring loads or any other objects;
- Do not raise or lower the forks or spears before fully stopping the tractor and applying the handbrake;
- Tilt the load backwards;
- Ride with the forks or spikes as close to the ground as possible with the harness angled backward (usually 10 to 15 cm (4 to 6 in.) above ground).
- Avoid sudden stops;
- Ensure there is sufficient headroom before entering or leaving a space, and lifting the forks or spears;
- Do not lift the load when the tractor is on an inclined terrain;
- Never transport anyone on the implement, forks, spears, harness;
